Through the generous support of our donors, the Springfield Foundation made grants totaling \$6,923,924 in 2015. The grants listed here support area nonprofit organizations that help make this community a great place to live.

In addition to the \$474,256 in Discretionary Grants listed in this brochure, in 2015 the Foundation approved:

Designated Grants totaling \$284,086 from 36 different funds to support organizations important to the donors;

\$4,403,501 from 46 Agency Funds in support of their missions;

and Donor Advised and Charitable Checking Funds supported charitable organizations across the country with grants totaling \$1,749,581.

Out-of-Cycle Discretionary Grants totaled \$7,500 and Executive Director Discretionary Grants totaled \$5,000.
